Our community members in attendance had many questions following this information.

Edgar asked how quickly IndyGo would be able to reassess transit lines considering the new Amazon Distribution Center and the Post Office Distribution Center that will soon be a massive job center for many people in our community. Jordan was unsure how quickly they would be able to make changes but said that IndyGo is able to reassess routes three times a year based on community recommendation and need. Jordan made a note and will report this concern to IndyGo.

Multiple community members in attendance asked if any new route with replace old Route 55 which served traffic east of English Ave. The main concern here is that residents now lose safe access to Kroger via bus route and will have to walk 20 minutes on roads with no sidewalks to access the grocery store. Jordan made a note and will report this concern to IndyGo as well.

Emily asked for a status update on lowering the road under the SSX bridge near Rural Street on behalf of Twin Aire resident Judo


151 YEARS IN THE MAKING
